LEGAL REPRESENTATION

Members can request legal support in situations where their rights are in question.

The Fund also provides access to legal advice at any time of the day or night as needed.

Fund lawyers have experience both working for and challenging government entities, and are familiar with the types of administrative and enforcement actions taken by governments against private citizens, farmers and families.

EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

Services include an educational website, information updates, and a members' website with access to business and cooperative models as well as a legal clearinghouse.

POLITICAL ACTION SERVICES

The Fund builds grass-roots activism through legislative alerts, petitions, and lobbying for laws and regulations favorable to direct-to-consumer distribution, raw dairy, on-farm processing, grass-based livestock operations, and sustainable vegetable & crop production.
